You could be a millionaire right now - here's where to find the latest Irish Lotto results. The Irish Lotto draw takes place every Wednesday and Saturday at 19:55 Dublin time. If your ticket matches all six main numbers, you'll be a winner with the €2 million jackpot. If there is no winner, the jackpot will roll over to the next draw. However, even if you don't match all six numbers, you can still win smaller prizes by matching five main numbers and the bonus ball or more. The smallest prize is €3, paid out for two main numbers and the bonus ball. The odds of winning the Thunderball lottery are extremely low, with only 1 in 10,737,573 chances of winning the main prize. However, there are ways to increase your chances slightly by placing bets on multiple columns or playing supplementary games such as Irish Lotto Plus and Irish Lotto Plus Raffle. To participate in the Irish Lotto, start by selecting your six numbers. If unsure, ask the attendant for assistance in choosing random numbers. You can fill out up to ten columns per ticket slip, but be aware that each additional column increases the bet price. Ensure you've marked all desired columns, ticked on when to place the bet, and handed it over to the attendant. A fee of €2.00 per column will be applied, with an additional €1.00 charge for participating in feature games. After payment, receive a bet slip that must be kept as proof of purchase. For online betting, log into your player account, navigate to the "GAMES" tab, and select Irish Lotto. Complete the online betting slip by filling in at least two columns with six main numbers between 1 and 47. Use Quick Pick for number selection if needed. Decide on participating in the Lotto Plus game. To claim your prize, familiarize yourself with the prize value table within 90 days of the draw date. Prize amounts range from €100 to over €10,000, with funds transferred directly to your linked online wallet after ID verification. Failure to verify or e-payment issues may result in a cheque being issued instead. The Irish Lotto has minimum and maximum bet limits, with the least being €2.00 per column and the most being €20.00 for a full ticket. Players can fill in between 1 to 10 columns on one bet slip and can also subscribe and bet on up to eight draws in advance. Irish Lotto offers an exciting jackpot of approximately €3,500,000 - €19,000,000 with a minimum jackpot amount of €2,000,000. You can place your bets online through the company's website or at their retail outlets. The Bonus Balls are important for both regular ticket holders and those who participate in Irish Lotto betting. There are seven balls drawn each game, including the Bonus Ball that creates additional prizes when you match two to five main numbers with it. Some bookmakers offer various bet types on the Bonus Balls, such as its color, whether it's odd or even, and even the exact number drawn. For instance, Paddy Power allows bets on these aspects, while Betfred offers odds of 75,000/1 for UK players who guess the three Bonus Balls correctly. To play the Irish Lotto, you can choose six numbers from 1 to 47 and have the option of adding a bonus ball. The goal is to match all six numbers plus the bonus number to win the jackpot. To participate in this game, you need to sign up for a ticket, which costs €2 per draw. To win the Irish Lottery jackpot, you need to match all six numbers drawn each week; however, matching just three numbers can also earn you a cash prize. The odds of winning the jackpot are approximately 1 in 10.7 million, which is considered favorable compared to other lottery draws. Meanwhile, your chances of winning any amount of money on the Irish Lottery are about 1 in 29. Irish Lotto is a popular game with a minimum jackpot of €1.7 million, costing €2 to play and offering great odds of winning any prize – just 1 in 29. The Irish Lotto has been a source of fortune for many since its launch in 1988, with Dublin emerging as a hub for jackpot winners. The small county of Louth boasts the highest number of winners per capita, while Carlow saw the largest-ever win in history. RTE One broadcasts the live draws, and players can catch up on missed draws online. The upcoming Lotto draw, set to take place on Saturday at 7:55 p.m., promises a jackpot of €5.8 million. Players have until 7:45 p.m. to purchase their entries, which cost €2 per line in-store, with an additional €1 for Lotto Plus. Online betting carries the same fees. The maximum jackpot currently stands at €19.06 million, and players can check their chances of winning on the Prizes page. Unclaimed prizes expire after 90 days and are placed into a reserve fund to be reused. Supplementary games like Lotto Plus and Plus 2 offer additional chances to win, with some requiring an extra €1 per line. Lotto winners in Ireland don't pay taxes on their prizes, but may be required to pay on any interest earned. Players from outside Ireland must follow their home country's tax laws if they wish to participate. The Irish Lotto Number Checker and results page provide convenient ways for players to check their entries and previous winning numbers. A notable syndicate from Co Mayo won the largest prize ever, valued at €19 million, in 2022.
