The third series of the BBC's Reported Missing once again follows police forces as they search for missing people across the UK. In the show's fourth episode, cameras follow Gloucestershire Constabulary as they attempt to track down local men Aaron and James, both of whom have gone missing separately in the same region. But where are Aaron and James from Reported Missing now?As The Sun reports, 37 year-old Aaron is homeless and a recovering drug addict, making him particularly vulnerable. He was first reported missing after a homeless healthcare centre noticed he hadn't been picking up his regular medication. Thankfully, Aaron was found safe at an address on Robinhood Street, where officers discovered him hiding in a bathroom. An update at the end of the episode revealed Adam had later received a community order for theft, going equipped to steal and resisting arrest, Gloucestershire Live reports. Elsewhere, James, a recovering drug addict, was reported missing after discharging himself from hospital against doctors' advice. After being spotted on CCTV, James was eventually tracked down by police after they received a call from a local pharmacy. The authorities encouraged James to return to hospital for medical treatment, but had no way of ensuring he would actually do so. Thankfully, it was later revealed James had indeed returned to hospital to continue his treatment and is now in recovery.Commenting on the Gloucestershire Constabulary's involvement in the BBC series, Deputy Chief Constable Jon Stratford revealed the force are "proud" to have been featured in a show which highlights the "challenging and complex work" that goes into searching for people who have gone missing. "Policing in Gloucestershire is not just about arresting people and preventing crime, but also about doing everything possible to help keep people safe from harm. It is an incredibly anxious time for relatives and friends of those who have left home, often with no indication of where they've gone," Stratford continued. "For policing it is also a demanding and resource-intensive period as we do all we can to try and find those who have disappeared and return them swiftly and safely to their families."Catch up with Reported Missing on BBC iPlayer. You may be able to find more information about this and similar content at piano.io Advertisement - Continue Reading Below Sept. 25, 2007, 12:10 AM UTC / Source: The Associated PressSpecial administrators appointed to look into the handling of James Brown's estate told a judge Monday that a former trustee may have misappropriated up to \$7 million of the late soul singer's money.The judge agreed that Brown's heirs could pursue those claims and ordered the ex-trustee to pay \$370,000 back to the estate, on top of \$350,000 the man repaid last month.State Circuit Judge Jack Early gave David Cannon, who has resigned as co-executor of Brown's will, 10 days to repay the additional \$370,000 and 20 days to pay \$30,000 for attorney fees and to produce other documents.Cannon, who sat away from Brown's two other trustees during Monday's hearing, did not show any reaction to the rulings. He refused to talk with reporters.Louis Levenson, an attorney for several of Brown's adult children and grandchildren, said the other trustees also mishandled Brown's money. "You can't turn your back on your responsibility and say it's his fault and then point your finger at Mr. Cannon," Levenson said.Levenson's clients are trying to remove all three trustees and have special administrators appointed to handle Brown's estate.The judge also ruled Monday that the attorneys general in South Carolina and Georgia can intervene on behalf of needy children who are supposed to benefit from Brown's "I Feel Good" Trust.Early did not hear a motion filed by a Houston woman claiming to be the Brown's daughter, who seeks to have everyone named in the will as Brown's child take a DNA test.Brown died in an Atlanta hospital on Christmas at age 73.
