So if a player is fouled on the line, referees award them with a penalty.Another important consideration:A player can be technically off the field of play while in possession of the ball, but as long as the ball is still on the pitch, the game continues as normal.This is totally different from basketball or American Football - where players are considered out of bounds as soon as their toe, or any part of their body, hits the line. Learning how your field is larger or smaller than your competitor's field can help you to strategize. What is the difference between a soccer field and an American football field? Well, if you're asking about the one at Subaru stadium (which this writer has witnessed a few games in), it's approximately 110 meters long and 68.5 meters wide. For example, if the attacking team gets a free kick outside the edge of the penalty area, the referee will automatically know that the defending team's wall should be placed at the penalty spot, which is 10 yards away, the correct distance the wall should stay in.
