Buried treasure maps are often obtained only as loot inside chests which are located in shipwrecks and underwater ruined structures respectively. Shipwrecks are small structures that resemble wrecked sailing ships. These are randomly generated deep in all oceanic biomes. However, there is a small chance of it generating beached above sea level, inside ocean monuments, icebergs, underwater ruins, or ravines. A regular shipwreck may contain up to 3 loot chests: a supply chest, a treasure chest, and a map chest depending on its generated sections that are still intact. Map chests are often generated in the lower section of the ship's stern. Underwater ruins or ocean ruins naturally generate underwater and they often resemble wrecked structures such as ruined huts and even one as large as an abandoned village. They are mainly composed of sandstone or stone bricks and are usually guarded by drowned mobs. At least 1 loot chest containing a buried treasure map is expected to be obtained within these ruins. Once you've acquired a buried treasure map, it's time to read it in order to locate where the treasure is buried. Start by holding the map in both hands. You can do this by holding the map with your right hand and simply dragging your mouse down. This will bring the map upwards revealing the entire map on your screen.Locate your position. When you see the map on your screen, you will also see that there is a white circle on the map. Depending on the size of the circle, it will tell you how close or far you are from the treasure. Based on the image below, the player is relatively close to the location shown on the map.Look at the treasure's coordinates on the map and locate where it is from your current position. Based on the image, the treasure is located North-East from where the player is currently standing.Open the coordinates menu and check the direction of which you are headed. You can open the coordinates by pressing F3 on your keyboard for PC users or FN + F3 for Mac users. This will show you information of your current location including the XYZ coordinates, current biome, and more.Take a look at the "Facing" information tab. This will show you the direction which you are currently facing whether it is in north, south, east, or west. Based on the map shown below, the player must head towards North-East. North-east is between north and east. You may choose to head in one direction first, or simply go diagonally.Head towards the direction of the treasure. Continuously move towards where the treasure is located while keeping tabs on the map. The white circle on the map will move along with how far and in which direction you are from the treasure chest. Once you are close enough, the map will open up and reveal the terrain of the land. Keep walking until you reach the X on the map before you start digging. The buried treasure will always be on the X facing east. Start digging until you find the buried treasure. It's usually buried in sand so preferably bring a shovel to make digging quicker and easier. If an area is unexplored, then the map will be uncolored and mostly appear tan. However, you can get a rough idea about the terrain based on the map features. A water body will be marked with horizontal orange stripes whereas dry land is marked with a flat tan color. Thankfully, the top of the treasure map is the north, left is west, right is east and down is south. So all you need to do is align yourself to the north of your Minecraft world and you'll get a rough idea of which direction you should head towards. CREDIT: MOJANG STUDIOS The second thing to be aware of is the player dot. The white circle you will see on any of the sides represents your current location. One clue as to whether you're headed in the right direction is the size of the dot. As the size reflects how far away you are from the borders of the map. If you notice that your dot is getting larger in size when you move, that's an indication that you're moving towards the marked location. When the size of the dot stops getting bigger, it means that you're less than 1027 blocks from the edge of the map. Once you're in the vicinity of the map, notice that the area around your dot will start to color in. This just means that you're exploring a previously unexplored place. Make sure to align the top of the arrow with the center of the X. Then all you need to do is to dig straight down and you should be able to find the treasure in no time! If you are on the Java edition, you can press the "F3" key on your keyboard to open up an information panel. You can find the direction you are facing from the left side panel here. If you are on the Bedrock edition, there's no way to bring up an information panel. You can try traveling in random directions until the player indicator moves and faces the treasure in the Minecraft treasure map. Alternatively, you can also use the sunrise and sunset to determine your direction. The sun rises from the East and sets in the West, even in the Minecraft world. As you already know, the treasure on your map is marked by a red cross (X). You also know that the four sides of the map indicate the real-world directions. So now, you simply need to find the geographical position of the X mark with respect to your location. In the above screenshot, the X mark on the buried treasure map is located in the North-East direction from my current location in my Minecraft world. So, North and East are the directions I need to head towards. Now that we know the basics, it's time to use the map to reach the X mark and dig out the buried treasure. Follow these steps to easily use a Minecraft treasure map and reach the spot: 1. Since you have two directions with respect to the buried treasure (in this case), you first need to move in one of these directions. If you move in the right direction, the map will start showing the biomes around you soon enough. Check out the following screenshot to see how it works. 2. Next, after you are parallel to the X mark on one side, it's time to move in the second direction. In the right circumstances, you should now see the white circular marker (your position) moving towards the X and uncovering the rest of the biomes on the map. Keep going until the player indicator is on top of the X mark. 3. Finally, it's time for you to dive down and dig on top of and around the X. In most cases, the treasure is either buried below the beach or underwater. But on rare occasions, you might find it on the side of a hill or even under the ocean floor. There are a few different map types in Minecraft, so it's okay if you get them confused; especially when looking at buried treasure maps versus ocean explorer maps. Buried treasure maps are why we're here. This is the map type in our guide, which leads you to a singular chest location. Ocean explorer maps on the other hand, lead you to an Ocean Monument. These are the giant, underwater structures filled with mobs and unique blocks. It's possible to stumble across one without a map, as they can easily be spotted from above (for example, if you are flying over with an elytra). All map types can be duplicated! The lower section may end up being on the top of the ship if it is overturned, so keep the ship's orientation in mind. If there is a map chest, there is a 100 percent chance it will contain a buried treasure map. Ocean Ruins Similar to shipwrecks, you can find ocean ruins underwater. They are a bit rarer than shipwrecks and can be quite treacherous to navigate. These structures are found in ocean biomes and appear to look like an underwater village. Within the buildings of an ocean ruin, there will be chests filled with loot. You have a 43 percent chance of finding a buried treasure map in these chests. Now that you have the buried treasure map, take a look at it. If you are not standing near the treasure, you will see landmasses outlined, with the ocean filled with orange stripes. As you come closer to the buried treasure, the map will fill in with color. In the image above, you can see the map has been partially filled in. Most of the time, you will find these chests on the beach or right off the coast. The treasure will be located at the red X. Although it's rare, you may find a chest in the center of the ocean. If this is the case, be sure to have Respiration and Aqua Affinity enchantments on your armor, so you can reach the bottom of the ocean without drowning. We suggest tackling a treasure map one axis at a time. First, move in a straight line following along two of the cardinal directions. While doing so, check the map to see how the dot is moving. There is a chance that the dot may be in the corner, so adjust until it slides up one of the edges. From here, you will need to choose between the two other directions. If you know for sure that an ocean is one way, then head that way. If you are a bit unsure, you could pick at random, but just know that you may be going the wrong way. If you notice a lack of water, consider turning around. Buried treasure will always generate near the center of the chunk. The world is broken into sections called chunks that aren't visible when playing. In the image above, you can see the chunk borders marked in white. The red portion is the center of each edge, with the yellow marking the 2x2 area that is the exact middle of the chunk. Treasure will be near this yellow area. You can easily turn on chunk borders by pressing F3 + G. Doing so will display all chunks. To turn off chunk borders, just press this again. When you get near the X on the map, turn on chunk borders and find the center blocks of the chunk. Dig down until you reach the treasure chest, and gather your rewards. The chunk borders shown will depend on the chunk you are standing in; every border will not be visible at the same time. There may be times when you don't have the patience to look for maps and want to skip straight to the treasure. While this may take a bit longer, it's not impossible. The good news is that buried treasure can generally be found in the same places that maps can, like coastal areas, shipwrecks, and the ocean floor. This includes Beaches, Snowy Beaches, and Stony Shores. However, it can be challenging to know where to start digging since buried treasure won't suddenly appear on the map when you are nearby. Based on the area it's located, the treasure may be covered by blocks matching its surroundings, like sand or gravel. Overall, stick to the beaches, turn on your chunk borders, and look for any bits of extra suspicious-looking sand. The buried treasure chests will have a variety of loot.

As you can see, you have a pretty good chance of finding every treasure. If you are playing on a server with others, there may be a chance that the chest has been looted already. If the area looks dug up, chances are, someone beat you to it. Sometimes, it may be difficult to tell if someone has already looted the chest. Fortunately, every buried treasure contains a Heart of the Sea. This means that if it is gone, someone has already looted the chest. Buried treasure chests are the only place that you can find the Heart of the Sea. At first, these may not seem too important, but don't get rid of them! A Heart of the Sea is incredibly rare and can be used to craft a conduit. Conduits are crafted structures that provide a variety of underwater buffs, similar to beacons. With a conduit nearby, you will have water breathing, night vision, and haste while underwater. Additionally, conduits will attack hostile mobs that are nearby. To make a conduit, you will need the following materials. 1x Heart of the Sea 8x Nautilus Shells Combining these items will create a placeable block. After making a shape like the one shown above, which serves as the frame, place the conduit in the center. This will cause it to activate. Conduit Layout Above, you can check out a gallery of images that take you step by step through the process of making a full conduit. You can also follow along with the steps below. Place down an 'X' made out of Prismatic blocks, with each line being five blocks (two coming out of each side from the center block. At the end of each 'arm', place four blocks going upward. In total, each side should have five vertical blocks. Place a second 'X' at the top of the vertical blocks. At this point, you will only need to place down five blocks to get this done. On each side, place an 'L' shape of Prismatic blocks that look like a hand going around the center. Lastly, place the conduit in the center. It should be one block off the base Prismatic; you can use any temporary block to work as a platform. After putting down the conduit, be sure to remove it. This conduit has been built on dry land so it's easier to see, but in the game, it needs to be underwater. How To Obtain Nautilus Shells Nautilus shells are also a bit difficult to obtain. You can purchase them from the Wandering Trader for five emeralds; however, they will only sell you five. Wandering Traders are a type of villager that can visit your base with a variety of goods. They will spawn within a 48-block radius of you, granted you are in an area where mobs can spawn. If you are working on a part of your base for a long period of time, there is a good chance that a Wandering Trader will appear. Drowned mobs have a three percent chance to hold a shell (eight percent on Bedrock edition) and will always drop it upon death. Lastly, nautilus shells can be obtained by fishing, but they are a rare item and will take some time to fish up. You're not going to believe how easy it is to find a buried treasure map in the game. To look for them, you need to look in underwater ruins chests and shipwreck chests. That's it - those are the two locations in Minecraft where you have the chance of finding a buried treasure map. But not all chests in those two locations will have the treasure maps. You'll know you've found one of the treasure maps when you see something that looks like yellowish paper as the small icon (see image below). That's your path to the treasure. As you can see in the image above, the chest had a treasure map that was moved to inventory. I know it doesn't really look much like a map, but trust me, that is the map you seek. How To Use A Minecraft Buried Treasure Map Okay, now that you've found a chest containing a buried treasure map, you're halfway there. It's not time to set out on a quest to discover this treasure. So, you just need to equip the treasure map in your hotbar, and then select it. That brings that map up to a larger size so that you can more easily follow it to the rich stuff. Just know that if you have something like a shield also equipped, then your map will show up slightly smaller than normal. As with any good buried treasure map, X marks the spot. So, you need to work your way through the world until you reach that big red X on the map. Not sure where you're starting from on this map? Well, your current position should be marked by a white cross. Of course, your current position might not be shown on the map because you are located somewhere off the map. In this instance, you'll see yourself as a white dot somewhere on the edge of the map. If this happens to you, then you need to start walking in the opposite direction in order to show up on the map. For instance, if your white dot is found on the northwest corner of the map, then start walking in a southeast direction to get on the map. I know that sounds kind of confusing, but that's just the way it works. How To Dig For Buried Treasure In Minecraft Okay, so once you have maneuvered your way through the lands to get to where that big red X marks the spot, it's time to dig up that buried treasure. That's right, the treasure is literally buried and you have to dig to uncover it. The tricky part is that red X is not an exact location, so you'll have to dig over a wide area in that general vicinity to uncover the hidden loot. Usually gravel or sand is what you'll have to dig through - but it may be a more durable material. What is the buried treasure? It will be a chest that contains five items for you. If the player's icon appears as a small white dot on either side of the map, it indicates that the player is far away from the marked treasure. Hence, the first thing the player needs to do is move in the correct direction

so that the white pointer returns to its normal size. Once they have achieved that, the player must make their way towards the X. Uncovering the chest in Minecraft Java Edition Even after reaching the X, players have a difficult time uncovering the chest. This occurs because new players start digging the area randomly to get to the chest. However, there is a simple trick that they can use to save time and figure out the exact blocks to dig. Upon reaching the X, place the white pointer facing in the upward direction and ensure it is completely hidden by the X. Then, move back slightly so that only a pixel of the white pointer can be seen under the X. If this is lined correctly, you can dig and find the treasure chest. If the chest is not at that spot, dig a small 3x3 area around it, and you should be able to uncover the chest. Uncovering the chest in Minecraft Bedrock Edition There are two ways in which players can unearth a buried treasure in the Bedrock edition. The first one is quite simple: players need to place the pointer right at the center of the X and dig a 3x3 hole right under their feet. The second method, though not complicated, uses basic mathematics. Similar to the first approach, line the pointer at the center of the X. Then, make sure that the X and Z coordinates are even numbers. Here is where the math part comes into play. Divide those numbers by 8. If the answer comes up to a whole number for both coordinates, dig straight down on that block to find the chest. If there is a decimal present, move around to nearby even coordinates until the answer sums up to a whole digit. Digging down to these coordinates will lead to the buried treasure.
