Thanks to HTMLPrettify package for Sublime, with little configuration change it is possible to use reformat functionality in vuejs .vue files. It is a simple configuration change that is needed for this to work. So first step is to install HTMLPrettify package if you already haven't. Open command palette cmd+shift+p and type HTMLPrettify: Set Plugin Options. In config file, under html options add "vue" as a allowed_file_extensions. After that with super+shift+h (default) keyboard shortcut you can easily beautify you vuejs components. You can also define custom options to be applied on ".vue" files. Open Prettify Preferences by typing HTMLPrettify: Set Prettify Preferences. Or through top menu: and add something like this: Find more about additional configuration on HTMLPrettify page. Sublime Text is a favorite text editor for programmers, Jerry feels that its most powerful feature is its open architecture, rich plug-ins to provide it with a variety of additional functions. As a front-end developer, it is often necessary to copy and paste some code from the Internet and make modifications, so a common requirement is to format the code copied into Sublime Text to make it indent, line break and other conform to the specifications. To this end, I searched the Internet for a very useful Sublime Text plug-in, specifically designed to beautify HTML code, called htmlprettify. When I use Package Control: Install Package, a built-in package management tool in Sublime Text: Encountered error message: Package Control: There are no packages available for installation. So the way to install plug-ins online is not clear, but thanks to Sublime Text's open architecture, I can go another way offline like Eclipse plug-ins. Go to GitHub repository and download the source code of HTML Prettify locally. **👉👉** Click the button "Clone or download" to download all the source code locally and decompose it into a folder: Then copy this folder directly into the Data/Packages of the Sublime Installation folder: This completes the installation of htmlprettify. Tool - > command panel or shortcut key Ctrl + Shift + P: Enter HTML Prettify to automatically beautify the currently open HTML code. The only issue is that I can't find any nice autoformat plugin/package that works with PHP. I found it for HTML.CSS etc (HTML-CSS-JS Prettify) and it works great, but none for PHP. Some that I found are not really doing the job greatly (I do it better manually) and not following WordPress standards in a way they do the job (for example they put register_sidebar code all in a single line). PHPTidy is what I'm hearing about all the time, but it's not working with ST3, only ST2. ST3 users, and everyone else, how do you format your PHP in WordPress? I use same package control item, but with ST2. ST3 was dumped when we watched it start auto overwriting RunDLL.dll and a few others with garbage code. Beta means beta. As far as ST2 goes, not being beta, ots folders are well laid out , so you can tweak Prettify a bit. Advice, don't bother. If you have a request, send it to the author at his package control page (best) or his homepage/Gist if you feel even more friendly. Tidy and Twig will do? Best practice, we think, was run prettify as you like, get used to what you can tolerate, and CTRL-H or manually dig through to your desired code profile. Profiles are a mystery, eh. Archive your custom packages before a quick reinstall, and Prettify HTML only seems to behave better and better. In this article we will be Sublime Text 3, SublimeLinter, SublimeLinter HTML Tidy, and HTML Tidy for Windows to lint some HTML code. Install Sublime Text 3 Install SublimeLinter Install HTML Tidy for Windows Install SublimeLinter HTML Tidy Install Sublime Text 3 Sublime Text 3 is a sophisticated text editor for code, markup, and prose. This is a free software to try and the trial period doesn't stop but it does have a pop up every so often that reminds to you play fair. Purchase the software like I did. It is a solid investment if you are going to do any coding. Install SublimeLinter SublimeLinter is a plugin for Sublime Text that provides a framework for linting code. With Sublime Text 3 open hold CTRL + SHIFT + P and type install Select Package Control: Install Package Type SublimeLinter Select SublimeLinter You will get a Package Control Message that says the package is installed Install HTML Tidy for Windows HTML Tidy for Windows is a binary that is needed by the SublimeLinter HTML Tidy plugin. It allows you to run Tidy on Windows. Navigate to the HTML Tidy for Windows website Select the tidy.zip link to download Extract the tidy.exe file to a place that SublimeLinter will have access to it For example C:\Users\Username\tidy Install SublimeLinter HTML Tidy SublimeLinter HTML Tidy With Sublime Text 3 open hold CTRL + SHIFT + P and type install Select Package Control: Install Package Type SublimeLinter-html-tidy Select SublimeLinter-html-tidy You will get a Package Control Message that says the package is installed To use tidy you have to point SublimeLinter to the tidy.exe file In Sublime Text 3 navigate to Preferences > Package Settings > SublimeLinter > Settings In the new window scroll down to paths Copy that section to the tab on the right "paths": { "linux": [], "osx": [], "windows": [] }, Enter your path to tidy.exe in the windows option { "paths": { "linux": [], "osx": [], "windows": ["~/.tidy"] }, } Note: You need to use forward slashes. Save the setting with CTRL + S Close the window Now open a HTML document and errors in your HTML will be displayed Although the question is for HTML, I would also additionally like to give info about how to auto-format your Javascript code for Sublime Text 2; You can select all your code(ctrl + A) and use the in-app functionality, reindent(Edit-> Line -> Reindent) or you can use JsFormat formatting plugin for Sublime Text 2 if you would like to have more customizable settings on how to format your code to addition to the Sublime Text's default tab/indent settings. You can easily install JsFormat with using Package Control (Preferences -> Package Control) Open package control then type install, hit enter. Then type js format and hit enter, you're done. (The package controller will show the status of the installation with success and errors on the bottom left bar of Sublime) Add the following line to your key bindings (Preferences -> Key Bindings User) { "keys": ["ctrl+alt+2"], "command": "js format" } I'm using ctrl + alt + 2, you can change this shortcut key whatever you want to. Firstly, while using Sublime Text 2 or 3: highlight the text you want to format, or select all text with 'ctrl + a'. Navigate to the drop down menu Edit -- Line -- Indent or 'ctrl +]' to add indentation to all selected textEdit -- Line -- Unindent or 'ctrl + [' to remove indentation from all selected textEdit -- Line -- Reindent to revert indentation to its original state before editIndent and Unindent will add or remove one indentation at a time. This is useful to remove indentation.To reformat the entire HTML document with indentation, aligned closing tags, and remove white space: Use an online "HTML beautifier"
