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## Wppsi iv sample test

To prepare your child for the WPPSI-IV, consider these sample questions and how you might ask them. The actual test may differ, so it's best to get familiar with what your child will encounter. ### Question Examples: 1. **Information**: Show a picture of an animal. Ask your child which one barks. 2. **Picture Concepts**: Display two rows of pictures. Ask your child to choose one from each row that goes together. 3. **Vocabulary**: Explain that a refrigerator is an object in the kitchen where you put food and drinks to keep them cool. 4. **Comprehension**: Tell your child who they should call if their house is on fire. 5. **Similarities**: Show two rows of items with one item open. Ask your child which item matches the others. ### Answers: - Bottom Right - 1 and 3 (Answer: An object in the kitchen to keep food cold) - Top Right (3rd from Left) - It's an object in the kitchen that you place food and drinks inside of to keep them cold/fresh. The Wechsler Preschool and Primary Scale of Intelligence Fourth Edition/WPPSI-IV test is designed for children aged 2.5 to 3.9 years old, with the core subtests taking approximately 45 minutes to complete. For older children (4 years and above), the test may be longer due to additional subtests. Here are five practice questions to familiarize yourself with the test format: 1. Identify a matching picture in one of four boxes. 2. Choose an item from the first row that corresponds to an item in the second row. 3. Show me the image labeled "oink". 4. Complete the sentence: Bananas and blueberries are both \_\_\_\_\_. 5. Why is playing with matches bad? Answers: 1. Bird, 2. Wheelchair and Bicycle, 3. Pig, 4. Fruit, 5. You could get burned.
