## How to unblock a number on a vtech phone

By Mandy Slake Sometimes you need to make calls to people you don't want to have your phone number. If you are worried about someone getting your phone number and are dialing a regular phone, you can block your caller ID and prevent your number from showing up on the other end. The person receiving your call will see the word "Unavailable," "Private" or "Restricted" instead of your phone number. Dial \*67 on your phone's keypad. Enter the number you want to call. Press the "SEND" button to initiate the call. Call your carrier by dialing \*611 from your cellular phone. If you are calling from another phone, dial the carrier's toll-free number. You can find the number on your bill, and on the carrier's website. Select the option to speak with customer care. Validate your account with the customer care agent. You may need to supply an account password or the last four digits of your social security number. Advise the representative you want a permanent caller ID block on your account. Dial \*82 on your phone keypad. Enter the number you want to call. Press the "SEND" button to place the call. i Old telephone image by Nenad Djedovic from Fotolia.com Modern technology allows you to hide your identity when placing almost any call from your home. However, at times it is practical to allow your dialed party to know that you are calling before she picks up the phone. You can unblock your home phone number on caller-ID devices on a per-call or a permanent basis, depending on your need. Dial \*92 on your phone. This is the universal code for unblocking your number if you have a per-line blocking service from your telecommunications provider. Dial the number of the party you wish to reach. Once the unblocking short code is entered, you may call your party as normal, and he will be able to view your number via caller ID. If your dialed party's caller ID also displays the name of the caller, then he will see that in addition to your phone number. Repeat as necessary. Because the \*92 universal code is only a temporary way to reveal your number, you will need to enter it before each call you would like to unblock. Call your service provider. Only your telecommunications provider will be able to permanently unblock any line that you have requested to remain hidden on caller IDs. Ask the customer service representative to remove per-line blocking on any line that you want to be known by your called parties. Inquire whether there are charges associated with ending the blocking service. A Vtech phone can be used to make a three-way, or conference, call. A three-way call connects you and two other people to the same conversation. All three participants in the call are able to chat freely with one another. The feature eliminates the need to go back and forth on the phone between two parties. You do not need to purchase any special equipment to use this feature. Depending on the model of your Vtech phone, the steps may vary slightly. Pick up the Vtech phone's handset and listen for the dial tone. Dial the number of the first party and wait for an answer. Press the "Flash" or "Talk" button on the phone's handset and listen for the dial tone. Dial the number of the second party and wait for an answer. Press the "Flash" or "Talk" button to connect both callers. Press the "Flash" or "Talk" button while on a three-way call to disconnect the second party. Hang up the phone to end the three-way call. The Vtech 5.8 is a cordless phone that allows you to add additional handsets to your main phone so that you can have quick access to phones in more than one location in your home. Only the main base has to be attached to a wall jack. The rest of the handsets connect to the main base via a wireless connection. You can access the phone's functions from the main phone, or any of the additional handsets. Open up the back of each handset that came with your Vtech 5.8 system. Plug in each battery to the handset and place the handsets on their chargers. Plug in the main base of the Vtech phone system. The main base normally is larger than the handsets and has an answering machine attached to it if your phone came with one. Connect the phone line to the main base of the Vtech phone and either the wall jack or modem, if applicable. Consult with your phone company if you are unsure about using the cable modem with your phone. Charge your main cordless phone completely before use. Connect any other phone bases that you may have by placing the charger in an electrical wall plug and attaching the opposite end to the phone base. Set up the answering machine that came with your Vtech 5.8 phone. To activate your voice mail, press the "Answer on/off" button at the base of the main cordless phone. Press "Setup" and then use the arrows to set the number of rings before the answering machine picks up. Press the "Announce" key on your Vtech 5.8 main phone base to listen to the greeting that people hear when they call you. Press "Record" to record a new greeting and then press "Announce" to listen to the greeting. Press "Play" on your Vtech 5.8 main phone base to listen to your voice messages. Press "Delete" to erase messages. Use any of the handsets to place phone calls. If a caller leaves a message, the handset will display that you have voice mail. Listen to the voice mail from your handset by pressing the "Play" symbol.
