This German-Tuned Ram 1500 Goes 1,250 Miles On A Tank Of LPG
JB Car Design - a German tuning outfit better known for its exquisitely executed tuned Porsche, Ferrari, and Lamborghini models - is taking a stab at that most American of vehicles: the pickup truck. Specifically, the outfit on Tuesday announced its rugged, rust-proof take on the Ram 1500, and it's like nothing we've seen before.That's because, where many firms are content to essentially fit an intake, raise the ride height, and bolt on some trinkets before calling it a day, JB Car Design seems to be spending tremendous time and effort getting the rust-proofing just right. Each Ram 1500 they build will literally be disassembled from the frame so that the cabin and bed can be hand-treated with protective coatings and cavity sealing, in the hopes that they'll stay whole at least as long as their engines do.Given that the Germans all but invented rust-proofing, we'd trust them to get it right. Under the hood, JB is taking a different tack, too, furnishing each 5.7L Hemi V8 with the necessary stuff to run Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) - a.k.a. propane - instead of gasoline. The result isn't much more potent, cranking out 428 hp to the Hemi's stock 395, but it is kinder to the environment. JB Car Design says the Ram achieves reductions of about 50% in hydrocarbon emissions, 85% in nitrogen oxide, and 95% in soot.Propane, it should be noted, is significantly cheaper than gasoline in Europe, so the fact the truck only manages around 16 miles per gallon isn't an issue.And then there's the driving range, which JB says is more than 2,000 km - about 1,250 miles - thanks to a pair of tanks with a total combined capacity of 352 liters, or about 93 gallons. Of course, JB Car Design's tuned Ram 1500 offers plenty of the more traditional tuner truck stuff, too - things like a modified grille, a custom hood with conspicuous black vents, an engine skid plate, and big 10-inch wide wheels wrapped in 33-inch-diameter off-road tires. On the roof, the truck can be optioned with a curved LED work light to match an available custom steel cage over the bed.Now, we've got bad news and worse news. The bad news is: JB Car Design's Limited Edition Ram 1500 is priced at about €120,000 - roughly \$134,000 US, at the current exchange rate. Since allen wrenches are small and fairly cheap, you'll probably find that one has been included with any at-home assembly furniture. However, allen wrenches can be useful on other ways around the house, especially if you do a bit more than just put together the odd bookcase or two. In that case, you'll want a range of allen wrenches to make sure you have the right size for every particular need.The good news is that just about every tool manufacturer has a range of allen wrench sets you can buy. You can find a chart of the allen wrench sizes from any manufacturer. You can more easily strip the head on a small allen wrench if you're not careful. So be sure that the hex bolt is clean before you insert the allen wrench and that you've inserted it with all six sides properly aligned. Also, if you buy a cheaper set of allen wrenches, the small ones may not be so precise in their measurements, which means they won't work as well (or eventually at all) within their size bolts. Getting stuck or stranded with a truck that isn't working has happened to a lot of us. And while it may seem inconvenient, the best way to tow a broken truck is to call a tow truck or get it on a trailer to tow it. However, if you don't have another option, it is possible to tow a full-size truck behind another truck. This method is by no means ideal, but can be utilized in a pinch using a tow strap or chain. Securely hook the tow strap or chain from one vehicle to the next. Do not hook to steering components or anything vulnerable, such as a tie rod end. It is best to hook the tow strap or chain to a receiver hitch on the front truck and a frame mount on the rear truck. Turn your flashers on as a warning for other vehicles. Do not tow for long distances. If you have more than a couple of miles to tow, it is much safer to call a tow truck or use a trailer. The person operating the rear truck must pay close attention to the truck that is towing and keep a decent amount of tension on the tow strap or chain. If there is a lot of slack on the tow strap or chain, you could potentially run it over or the front truck could start going too fast to compensate for the loss of tension. To measure your foot in inches, we'd recommend using a tape measure. You can find approximate foot lengths in millimeters in the chart above. Occasionally shoe sizes can seem to vary from brand to brand by up to half a size, so when possible, it's always worth trying the shoes on first. Alternatively, look for online retailers with free returns policies and sizing guides. For the chart above, we've done our research and based the conversion on the majority of online retailers, but if you're thinking of buying from a specific retailer, it's worth checking their own conversion chart if they have one. In Canada, Men's sizes are approximately 1.5-2 sizes smaller than women's. For example a Canadian men's size 7 would be a Canadian women's size 8.5. It's often hard to tell if a supplier is listing their shoe size in Canadian, UK or AU sizes - so we find the best way is to check your European shoe size and use that as a guide. While shoe size is not a definite factor in height, there has been a general correlation drawn by data analysts such as StatCrunch. Often taller people tend to have larger feet, however this is not absolute. The easiest way to convert shoe sizes is to use a shoe size conversion chart, like the one above. You couldn't be more excited—you finally get to buy that adorable pair of miniature Baby Jordans. But does your baby really need them? Well, yes and no. When a baby first begins to toddle—typically between 8 and 18 months—there's no need for him or her to wear shoes inside the house. But outside, those tender feet need protection. The trick to finding the right shoe is making sure it fits. Though a little extra space in the toe is necessary, don't try to make footwear purchases last longer by buying shoes a few sizes too big. A novice walker has enough trouble without slipping out of his or her shoes. When your baby's trying on shoes, watch your child's response. If a pair seems to hurt or if they are having trouble walking, take them off. Avoid trendy styles especially those with pointy toes, which can pinch tiny toes and restrict growth. Also avoid clogs, which look cute but fall off easily. While the best way to ensure you're getting the correct shoes for your baby is to try them on, there are times when that's not possible. Maybe you're buying baby shoes as a gift and you found the perfect pair but it's a U.K. or European brand. Or, maybe you found a deal online you just can't pass up. Whatever your reason, you'll need a chart to help you determine which shoe size to buy for the special baby in your life. Average age is an average. If the baby you're buying for is big for his/her age, the clothing size column may be a better indicator of what shoe size to buy. European and UK baby shoe brands tend to run larger, on average, than American baby shoe brands; a size 18 E.U., for example, is more like a 3.5 U.S. Most brands have specific sizing charts for their shoes; look to see if you can find one on their website to help you make the best choice. Measuring a baby's foot can be a challenge! Here is a video that shows how to get a proper foot measurement of your wiggly little one. The back of the shoe should be snug but comfortable. If a baby's heel slides out easily, the shoe is too big; if the shoe pinches the heel, it's too small. It Takes Two: Have a salesperson measure both of your child's feet. Most babies have as much as a half-size difference between feet. Always buy shoes to fit the larger foot. Go High Style: For babies between the ages of 9 and 18 months, high-top sneakers and soft leather ankle boots will stay on better than low-cut styles. Keep Tabs: Toddlers outgrow their shoes quickly. A new pair may be too small after just three to four months. To ensure a proper fit, do the thumb test every few months. Get In The Groove: Moderately grooved rubber soles go a long way toward preventing a wobbly toddler from slipping. Try roughing up the soles of slick-bottomed shoes with sandpaper for better traction. Guys, there's more to your shoe size than the length of your feet. The width of your feet should also be taken into account for a proper fit. Shoe width is just as important as shoe length. As you'll see in chart below, shoe widths are defined as "narrow," "wide" and "standard," although there really is no "standard" width. Measurements vary from brand to brand. Keep shoe width in mind next time you purchase a new pair of shoes, especially if you have wide or narrow feet. Trace each of your feet on a piece of paper on a flat surface. Make sure you trace both of your feet, as your feet could vary in size, and keep the pen/pencil/markr perpendicular to the paper so you don't trace underneath your feet. Determine your width by using a ruler to measure the widest points of your feet. If your widths are different, use the largest measurement to determine your shoe width size. Now that you have your measurements, you can easily determine where you fall on the U.S. men's shoe size and width chart below. B, N, and C denote narrow widths; D, M and R denote medium and standard widths; and 2E, E and W denote wide widths. There are additional letters and numbers that denote widths that are extra narrow and extra wide. A, S, 2A and 3A denote extra narrow widths and 4E, EE and WWW denote extra wide widths. These numbers and letters certainly don't make determining your shoe size a simple process. Visiting a shoe store and getting fitted by a salesperson who understands proper measurements will eliminate confusion and make finding the perfect pair of shoes easy, but understanding your width and true shoe size will help you get a comfortable, proper fit if you're ever shopping for shoes on your own.
