These stations participate in the State's Consumer Assistance Program and are inspected monthly by the State of California. They also perform smog repairs on participating vehicles. Vehicles are selected for STAR smog check using three strategies: Gross Polluters, High Emitter Profile vehicles, or a random sample of all registered vehicles driven on public roadways. If your vehicle is chosen, find a convenient STAR certified smog station and proceed with the inspection; the technician can inform you of any serious issues. STAR smog stations have varying prices, typically between \$29.95 and \$59.95 plus a State Certificate fee of \$8.25. Find a STAR station using our smog station search tool. A Test & Repair smog station can inspect, repair, and certify vehicles, while a Test Only center can only conduct a smog test and is not allowed to perform repairs or comment on diagnosis. If your vehicle fails at a Test Only center, seek repairs at a Test & Repair station, which may charge an additional smog inspection fee. Smog test only stations are not allowed to profit from repairs and must direct you to a licensed repair station for any necessary work. The cost of a Test Only smog check is generally the same as that of a STAR smog check, but prices can vary between centers.
