Finding NDS Files Can Be a Challenge. But with the Right Tool, You'll Be Playing Your Favorite Games in No Time!!! Looking for nDS files can be an overwhelming task. Some specialized nDS file-finding tools come in handy to speed up the process. These tools allow you to input the nDS name and output the file in an organized list. Once you have your nDS files, you'll need to convert them into a CIA format, so that you're able to play them on your 3DS. What is a CIA File? A CIA File (CTR Installable Archive) is a type of game file created by Nintendo for their 3DS devices. This file format allows you to install and run games on the 3DS. You must note that not all nDS files can be converted into CIA files, as not all nDS games are compatible with the Nintendo 3DS hardware. To check if your nDS files are compatible, you'll need to consult an online nDS game compatibility list. Using GodMode9 to Convert Your Files Once you've located your nDS files and verified that they're supported on the 3DS, you can use the GodMode9 tool to convert those files into the CIA format. GodMode9 is a powerful command-line tool developed by the 3DS modding community. It allows you to perform various operations on the 3DS, including converting nDS files into CIA files. To use GodMode9, you'll need to launch the homebrew tool onto your 3DS. This process isn't difficult, but it does involve a few extra steps, such as downloading and installing the "FBI" application on the 3DS. Once you have the tool running, you'll be able to access the GodMode9 file manager, and you can locate your nDS files. Using Citra Emulator Another option is to convert your NDS files into a CIA format using the Citra emulator. This emulator allows you to play NDS games on your PC. With Citra, you can easily turn an NDS file into a CIQ file. The process isn't as complicated as using GodMode9, but it does involve a few extra steps, such as downloading the Citra executable and setting up a 3ds user folder. Playing Your Games Once you've converted your nDS files into a CIA format, you'll be able to play the game on your 3DS. To do this, you'll need to install the CIA file into the 3DS. This is done by launching the "FBI" application and selecting the "Install CIA" option from the FBI menu. You can then select the CIA file that you want to install. Installing a Game Cartridge Directly Installing a game cartridge directly to the system isn't recommended, but it's possible with GodMode9. To do this, you'll need to press and hold Start while powering on your device. This will launch GodMode9. Navigate to [C:] GAMECART and select the nDS file by pressing A on .trim.3ds. Then, select NCSID image options..., and Install game from there. Press A to unlock SysNAND (v11) writin, then input the key combo givin. Once the process is complete, your game will show up in the HOME Menu as an instal title. Dumpin a game cartridge Press and hold Start, and while holdin Start, power on your device. This will launch GodMode9 Navigate to [C:] GAMECART Follow the steps applicable to your game cartridge: 3DS Game Cartridge: Press A on .trim.3ds to select it, then select NCSID image options..., then select Decrypt file (0:/gm9/out). NDS Game Cartridge: Press A on .nds to select it, then select Copy to 0:/gm9/out Trimmed dumps are not recommend for NDS games in general, as they can cause various playback issues Your non-installable .3ds or .nds formatted file will be outputted to the /gm9/out/ folder on your SD card Dumpin a 3DS game cartridge to CIA Press and hold Start, and while holdin Start, power on your device. This will launch GodMode9 Navigate to [C:] GAMECART Press A on .trim.3ds to select it, then select NCSID image options..., then select Build CIA from file Your instalable .cia formatted file will be outputted to the /gm9/out/ folder on your SD card Dumpin an instal title Press and hold Start, and while holdin Start, power on your device. This will launch GodMode9 Press Home to bring up the action menu Select Title manager Select one of the followin depending on the type of title you wish to dump User Instal Title: [A:] SD CARD System Title / DSiWare: [1:] NAND / TWL Select the title you wish to dump Select Manage Title... Select Build CIA (standard) Your instalable .cia formatted file will be outputted to the /gm9/out/ folder on your SD card Backup GBA VC saves Do the followin process for each GBA VC game that you want to back up the save for: Launch the GBA VC game Exit the GBA VC game Power off your device Press and hold Start, and while holdin Start, power on your device. This will launch GodMode9 Navigate to [S:] SYSNAND VIRTUAL Press A on agbsave.bin to select it Select AGBSAVE options... Select Dump GBA VC save Press A to continue Press Start to reboot your device Restore GBA VC saves Do the followin process for each GBA VC game that you want to restore the save for: Launch the G3BA VC game Exit the GBA VC game Power off your device Press and hold Start, and while holdin Start, power on your device. This will launch GodMode9 Navigate to [0:] SDCARD > gm9 -> out Press Y on the .gbavc.sav file you wish to restore to copy it Press B to return to the main menu Navigate to [S:] SYSNAND VIRTUAL Press A on agbsave.bin to select it Select AGBSAVE options... Select Inject GBA VC save Press A to continue Press Start to reboot your device Launch the GBA VC game Exit the GBA VC game Encryptin / Decryptin a CIA file Press and hold Start, and while holdin Start, power on your device. This will launch GodMode9 Navigate to [0:] SDCARD -> cias Press A on the .cia file to select it, then select CIA image options... Select the option to perform the desired function: Encrypt to 0:/gm9/out: Create an encrypted copy of the selected .cia file in the /gm9/out/ folder on your SD card Decrypt to 0:/gm9/out: Create a decrypted copy of the selected .cia file in the /gm9/out/ folder on your SD card Encrypt inplace: Replace the selected .cia file with an encrypted version Decrypt inplace: Replace the selected .cia file with a decrypted version Your encrypted / decrypted .cia will be outputted to the desired location This page was last edited on 23 April 2025, at 01:14. The conversion process is similar to converting .nds files to .cia, but with some differences in steps. After installing GodMode9, you can use it to convert your 3DS games by following these steps:
