
### THREE NOTE PER STRING THREE OCTAVE VOODOO BLUES SCALES- A summary.

The Voodoo Blues Scale (1,b3,4,b5,5,6,) layed out as 1 octave 3 NPS patterns in all positions. I have also included a position starting on the b5, referred to as Position 3a rather than 4, so that the other positions still line up over the traditional blues box of the same number.
